<b>Job Title</b>	Casual Technician, Braintree Arts Theatre
<b>Responsible to</b>	Theatre and Technical Manager
<b>Job Purpose</b>	To provide technical support to facilitate the smooth running of an event, performance or hire.
<b>Duties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To undertake technical duties as directed by the Theatre Manager</li><li>• To maintain the efficient running of the control room, workshop, stage and backstage including equipment maintenance, operating and cleaning</li><li>• To receive and deal with enquiries from visiting companies, hirers and colleagues either electronically or in person.</li><li>• To work with the Theatre Manager to disseminate information as required.</li><li>• To assist with load in, rigging and derigs</li><li>• To ensure a safe working environment in all areas</li><li>• To operate sound and lighting equipment</li><li>• To maximise income and minimise expenditure wherever possible, including assisting with front of house duties</li><li>• To input and ensure the accuracy of data onto the computer</li><li>• To accurately log PRS data</li></ul>
